# Jewish people believe in one God

 Synagogue		A <b>synagogue</b> is a Jewish place of worship.
 Torah		Stories from the Jewish Bible, the <b>Torah</b> teaches Jews about God looking after his people.
 Ark		The <b>Ark</b> is where the Torah is kept.
 Mezuzah		A <b>mezuzah</b> is placed on a doorway. Jews touch it as they pass. It reminds them of God.
 Shema		The <b>Shema</b> is the most important Jewish Prayer about God.
 Shabbat		<b>Shabbat</b> is the Jewish Day of rest. It happens every week and reminds Jews of how God created the world in six days and rested on the seventh.
 Hanukkah		<b>Hanukkah</b> is a Jewish holiday, also known as the Festival of Lights.
