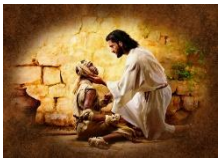
**GOSPEL** Where, on 'The Big Frieze' can you see the Gospel frame?

People liked listening to Jesus. He shared stories that showed people what kind of world he wanted.

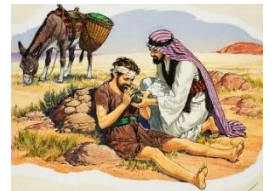
Jesus chose 12 **disciples**, who he then made **apostles**. They learnt from him while he lived and continued to spread his teachings after he died.



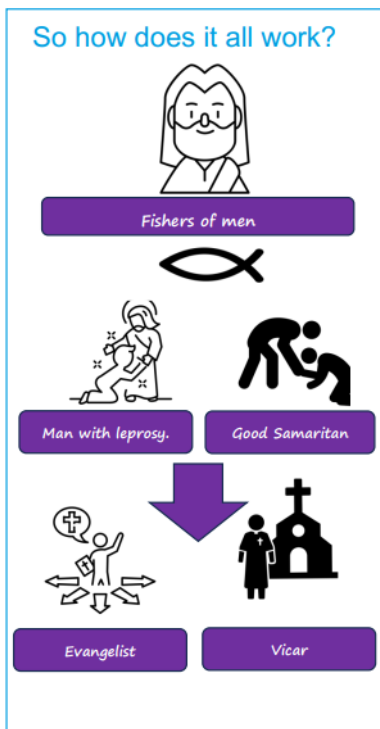
Christians today try to follow Jesus and be 'fishers of people'. The healing of the leper is a story where Jesus showed love to the most vulnerable and rejected. The Good Samaritan is a story that tells us to love everyone even if that someone is not our friend.



Jesus wanted us to learn that the kind thing to do is to offer help to anyone who needs it.



Churches try to create a world, just as Jesus would have wanted. Churches want to show love for others.



Clergy	All of the people who are ordained for Christian ministry.
Galilee	A lake in Judea around which Jesus did much of his teaching
Vicar	A person in charge of a church.
Samaritan	A person from the land of Samaria, a group of people whom the Jewish people disliked.
Gospel	The good news about Jesus, a book of the New Testament recounting Jesus' life.
Evangelist	Someone who shares good news about Jesus through preaching and teaching.
