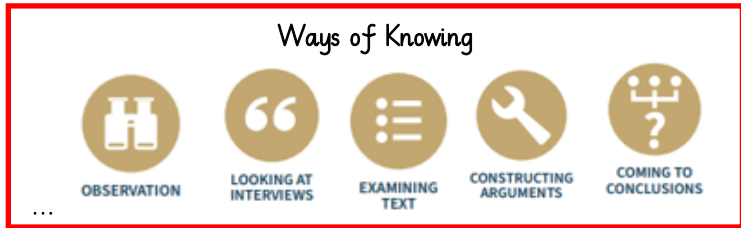

Aum is the most sacred symbol in Hinduism which is used by many Hindus to represent **Brahman**.

Hindus have more than one God; they have three main Gods and known as the **Hindu Trinity**.



- ❖ **Brahma**, who creates the universe.
- ❖ **Vishnu**, who preserves the universe.
- ❖ **Shiva**, who destroys the universe.

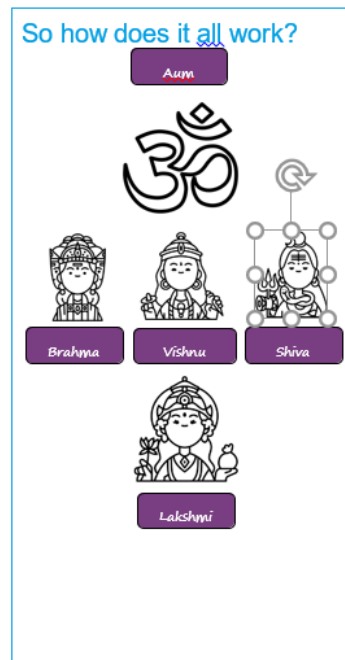


Hindus often choose a deity to worship at a shrine in their own home. This worship is called '**Puja**'.
